

#34 Inter Europol Competition

The team

Since 2010 the Inter Europol Competition team runs different cars in different championships. This year the team also participates with two LMP3 in the European Le Mans Series.

The team and Le Mans

- 2019: saw the first participation of the Inter Europol Competition in the 24 hours of Le Mans with the Ligier LMP2 after winning the Asian Le Mans Series 2018 - 2019 season. The #34 started from 18th and finished 16th in LMP2.
- 2020: second participation, again with the Ligier LMP2. The #34 started from 21st in LMP2 and finished 17th.
- ✓ 2021: first participation with the Oreca LMP2. We are keeping our fingers crossed!

Poland and Le Mans

- 1932: the F1 driver Stanislaus Czaykowski, entered the race with a Bugatti Type 55.
 And 1933: he entered a Bugatti Type 51 with another French co-driver Jean Gaupillat. This privately entered team retired both years.
- ✓ 1972: Jean Daniel Jakubowski was co-driver in an English built prototype Taydec. It failed to start.
- ✓ 2015: the first Polish driver to finish the race was Jakub Giermaziak. He co-drove the JMW Motorsport Ferrari 458 to 7th in class.







From 2010 till today

✓ **144** races (with both LMP2 and LMP3)

- ✓ **50** podium places: 14 first 21 second 15 third
- 7 not classified
- ✓ 5 DNF
- ✓ 1 retired



- 2. Outside of motorsports I am probably most proud of the relationship with my family. We are a very close and strong family unit and we support each other a lot.

Kuba:

- 1. My best decision in motorsports was the switch to endurance racing. It is where I feel most comfortable.
- Actually, there are two things. First, I am proud of my father. He build Inter Europol into what it is today. And then the other thing, what very few people know, is that I rescue rats from laboratories and give them a good life for the rest of their lives.
